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DECLARATION OF PRIVATE RIGHT-OF-WAY

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MADE and concluded this ZZul day of February 1999, by Gulf USA Corporation, owners of land situated Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania, party of the first part, **GRANTOR**,

-AND-

Gulf USA Corporation, interim owner of Lots 26-70 of Moshannon Forest I I Subdivision, situate in Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania, its heirs, beneficiaries, and assigns, party of the second part, **GRANTEE**:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Gulf USA Corporation has laid out an approved subdivision in Snow Shoe Township known as Moshannon Forest I, recorded in Centre County Plat Book 56 Page 160 and whereas that plan included a declaration of private right-of -way, recorded in Centre County Record Book 1022 Page 353 which declared Lucas Road as a right-of -way for access to Moshannon Forest I parcels as well as to future parcels to be subdivided by Gulf USA Corporation and,

WHEREAS, the said Gulf USA Corporation, is in the process of subdividing certain lands in Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, PA, known as the "Moshannon Forest II" prepared by Shope Surveying Co. dated and.

WHEREAS, in said subdivision, several fifty foot (50') wide right-of-ways have been laid out, providing access to the various lots of the subdivision across and through lands of the Subdivision, said right-of-ways being designated as Lucas Ridge Road, Ferd's Road, Whippoorwill Lane and Quarry Road on the above referenced plan; and,

WHEREAS, a full description of said fifty foot (50') wide right-of-ways is hereto annexed and made part hereof and labeled "Exhibit A" and,

WHEREAS, the said "Gulf USA Corporation" has applied to the Centre County Planning Commission for approval of said Subdivision Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre County Planning Commission, as a condition precedent to the approval of said Subdivision Plan, has required the receipt of a written instrument evidencing the use and maintenance of the said fifty foot (50') wide perpetual right-of-ways, shown as Lucas Ridge Road, Ferd's Road, Whippoorwill Lane, and Quarry Road, as more fully described herein as "Exhibit A", said perpetual easements to provide access from Township Road 325, and Moshannon Forest I Subdivision to and through the various lots of the Subdivision more fully described and depicted on the Moshannon Forest II aforementioned Plan; and to other parcels which may be subdivided by Gulf USA or others from Parcel 4 of Centre County Record Book 776 Page 277 or Centre County Record Book 957 Page 540 and,

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WHEREAS, it is the intention of this instrument to provide for the declaration and granting of said private right-of-ways to provide perpetual access to the designated land of the Grantees herein; and.

WHEREAS, all of the parties hereto are desirous of said Roads remaining private right-of-ways and are desirous that they shall be maintained by the respective parties hereto, as hereinafter set forth; and,

WHEREAS, said Gulf USA Corporation, as owner of all lands affected herein, executes this agreement and declaration as both Grantor, being the current owner and/or equitable owner, and as Grantee, being the owner and/or equitable owner of the various lots being credited by the Subdivision Plan with the expressed understanding that the rights and obligations of this declaration will be assigned and transferred to all future lot owners and that reference to this agreement will be made on the Final Plan of said Subdivision prior to Plan recordation.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, for themselves, their heirs, administrators, successors, and assigns, do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The Grantors and Grantees hereto, for, and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein set forth, and the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00), lawful money of the United States, to them will and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby covenant and agree with each other, that the fifty foot (50') wide private roads, as described in Exhibit A, hereto, shall be fifty foot (50') wide private right-of-ways extending from Moshannon Forest I to and through lands of Moshannon Forest II, to provide access to the various lots shown on the aforementioned Subdivision Plan dated December 2, 1998 as amended, and to future parcels to be sold by Gulf USA Corporation or others beyond this property if said parcels are subdivisions of Centre County Record Book 776 Page 277 Parcel 4 or Record Book 957 Page 540.
- 2. The Grantors do hereby covenant and agree that the said Private Roads shall be private easements for the right of free ingress, egress, and regress, to and for the use, in common, of the above named Grantees, their assigns, their guests, heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, including tracts of land to be subdivided in the future. Owners of Lots shown on the above-mentioned Plan, their heirs, successors and assigns, by this declaration obligate themselves to accept any extension of these roads or other roads in future subdivided lands which use these roads to access them.
- 3. The parties hereto do hereby covenant and agree, one with the other, that the said Private Roads shall continue to be private right-of-ways, fifty feet (50') in width, to provide full and free ingress, egress, and regress to and for the said parties hereto, their guests, and their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to be used in common with the parties hereto, their heirs, and assigns, all hereby stipulating that the said roads shall forever be and remain open as private right-of-ways to the parties hereto, as hereinbefore provided.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular, the privileges unto them, the parties hereto, their heirs and assigns, forever.

4. The parties hereto further covenant and agree that the said roads shall be used and maintained by the parties hereto, their heirs, successors, and assigns that they will each maintain and/or improve said right-of-way in common, so that the said roads shall be forever open and passable for the private use of the parties hereto, as hereinabove set forth. The cost of maintenance and/or improvement shall be

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distributed equally among the lot owners on a pro rata basis based upon the number of lots owned by any individual or group as per Moshannon Forest Property Owners Association Bylaws.

- 5. Heavy Hauling: Normal delivery of stone, building supplies, etc., are considered normal use of said roads. Hauling of logs and logging equipment will also be allowed, but when any property owner intends to haul more than five (5) loads of logs or timber products, that property owner shall be responsible to repair any damage to the roads, drainage facilities or seeded areas, which he or his contractor causes.
- 6. The decision to maintain and/or improve all or any portion of the roadway shall be made by majority vote and the cost shall be distributed among the appropriate lot owners per Article 4 above. The decision to pave any portion or the entirety of the roadway system shall require a vote of 75% of all lot owners, including future phases of Moshannon Forest Subdivision.
- 7. This agreement is entered into by the parties hereto with the expressed understanding that the quality of the roadway shall be maintained as a sixteen foot (16') wide stone stabilized cartway six inches (6") in depth in conformance with the standards and details depicted on the aforereferenced Subdivision Plan and as approved by the County Planning Commission as relates to said Plan approval.
- 8. In the event all of the parties hereto do not agree to the repair and/or improvement of said right-of-way, each party shall have the right, but not the duty, to improve and/or repair said right-of-way at his, her, or their expense.
- 9. The parties utilizing said right-of-way, and the grantor herein, shall have the right to install and maintain any necessary public and/or private utilities within the fifty foot (50') right-of-way, providing that said utilities shall not interfere with the rights of ingress, egress, regress, and other utilization of said right-of-way.
- 10. In addition to the above, Bob's Lane, as shown in the aforementioned plan shall be a 30 foot wide right-of-way to allow access to the stream by property owners of Moshannon Forest Parcels. This access shall be limited to pedestrian, all terrain vehicles, and four (4) wheel drive automobiles. This access Right of Way shall be maintained by the Property Owners Association to minimize erosion and sedimentation. All other covenants previously listed for the other roads shall apply to Bob's Lane except for right of way width, cartway width and the use limitations aforementioned.
